SPRING GROVE AREA HIGH SCHOOL 2022-2023 School Profile

Spring Grove Area High School is a four-year comprehensive high school with an enrollment of approximately 1,100 students and a faculty consisting of 85 members.

COMMUNITY

Spring Grove is located eight (8) miles west of York, Pennsylvania and ten miles north of the Maryland border. The major employer in Spring Grove is Pixelle, a paper manufacturer. The District is largely rural, including several boroughs and municipalities. The total district student population is approximately 4,700.

GRADING SYSTEM

Courses are assigned a value or *weight* according to the degree of difficulty of the course content. The weighted GPA is determined by computing the product of the grade, weight, and credit for each course and dividing the sum of the products by the total number of credits. Students also receive a cumulative *unweighted* GPA based on a 4.0 scale. The unweighted GPA is calculated by converting the letter/percentage grade for each course to the 4.0 scale and dividing the sum of all the courses by the total number of credits.

GRADING SCALE

A = 90-100%

B = 80-89%

C = 70-79%

D = 65-69%

F = below 65%

WEIGHTING SYSTEM

The weighting system (since the 2013-2014 school year) is:

• Level 1 (Normal): 1.0

• Level 2 (College Prep): 1.05

• Level 3 (Honors): 1.1

Level 4 (AP/CiHS): 1.15

CLASS RANK

Class Rank is based on cumulative weighted averages and calculated twice each school year (mid-year, end-ofyear).
