



## **Getting Started Guide**






The first thing you will see is the course map. Courses are normally broken down into Units, Topics, and Lessons. Most lessons have 5 activities (Warm Up, Instruction, Summary, Assignment, and Quiz); however, there are a few other activities that may show up periodically.

The course map shows what needs to be completed each day to stay on pace.



You can click the graph icon on the left to view the Progress Overview. Here you will see multiple grading metrics (Overall, Actual and Relative Grade), your progress bar, and a break down of grades by category.



## **Grading Metrics:**

Overall Grade: Average score of all assignments completed.

Actual Grade: Average score of all assignments completed adjusted for pacing.

Relative Grade: Final course grade if no more progress is made.

\* If you are on pace, the Overall and Actual Grades will be the same.

## Categories:

<u>Quiz</u>: Each lesson ends with a 10-question quiz. Students get 2 attempts.

<u>Test</u>: Each topic ends with a 25-question test. Students get 1 attempt.

<u>Assignment:</u> Graded assignments include - Online Content, Journal, and Practice. The computer will automatically assign a score, your teacher will review these submissions, provide feedback, and may adjust your score.

When you click the **Course Report** button, a real-time report will display. It shows a list of activities, with the submission date, time spent, and score (if applicable). Use this report to track your progress and review your scores on individual assignments.
