Status of Fiscal Year 2022

-23

Revenues

- Collected \$805K more than budgeted in real estate taxes
- BEF and SEF \$1.55 million more than budgeted

Expenditures

- Assuming not spending \$350 K Budgetary Reserve
- Working through projections for staffing, LIU contract cost, and charter school cost
- Leveldebt payment \$688K
- Other expenditures tracking as budgeted

Grants

ESSER, PCCD, DOJ

Status of Fiscal Year 2022

Overall projecting a smaller deficit than budgeted

- Original \$5.8 Million
- Updated \$2.0 Million

Update of 2023 -24 FY Budget

Governor's Proposed Budget*

- Basic Education Subsidy \$862K
- Special Education Subsidy \$274 K
- Accountability Block Grant (ABG)- No Change
- Possible Total Increase \$ 1.13 million

Spring Grove's Budget

No increase in Basic and SpecialEd subsidies from 2022-23

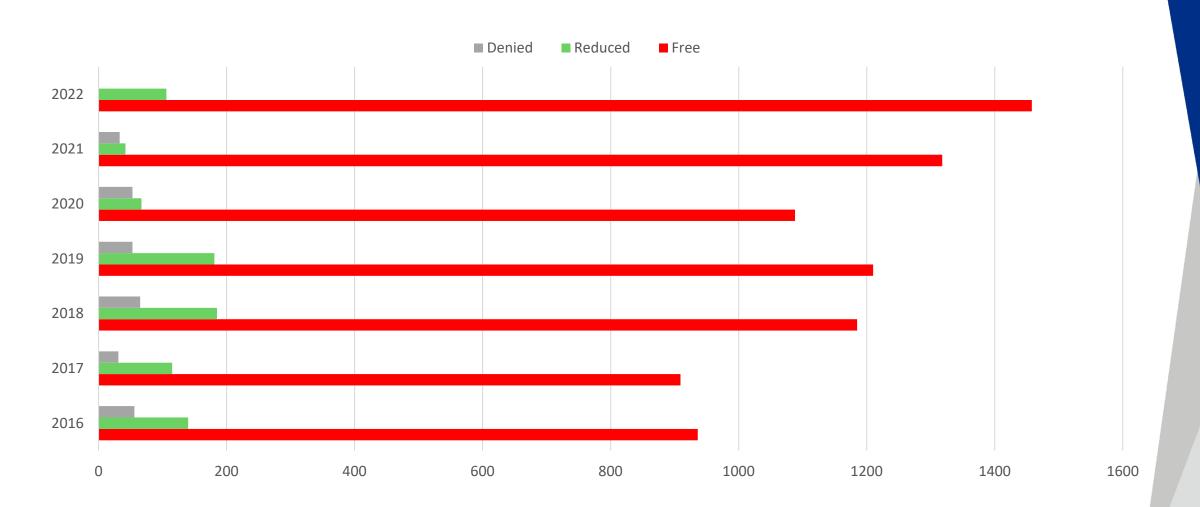
