Course Title: Publishing

Grade Level(s): 9-12

Units of Credit: .5

Classification: Elective

Length of Course: 30 cycles

Periods Per Cycle: 3

Length of Period: 43 minutes

Total Instructional Time: 64.5 hours

Course Description

This course introduces students to publishing software, including Microsoft Publisher and Adobe InDesign. Throughout the year when approached, students will utilize Microsoft Publisher to create publications for various school and community initiatives. For the majority of the year, students will utilize Adobe InDesign to learn how to create, while discovering how to improve, the layout of the school's newspaper. Focus – MS Publisher and Adobe InDesign Please note: Journalism 1 students are required to take this course concurrently with Journalism 1 as a prerequisite for Journalism 2.
